This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries that were raised during the Pre-bid Conference, with online coverage, on 13 September 2022 at 10:00 AM at the BCDA Corporate Center and queries sent through e-mail by prospective bidders, as well as other matters relative to the **PROCUREMENT OF BCDA IT SOFTWARE ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION 2022**.

QUERIES	CLARIFICATION/S
Whether the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for Lot 1 (AutoCAD / Autodesk / Sketchup Pro) can be changed in relation to the increase in the current pricing of the Autodesk Infrastructure Design Suite Premium (AECC)? If not, can the quantity of AECC be decreased?	In relation to the increase in the current pricing of the Autodesk Infrastructure Design Suite Premium (AECC), the number of the AECC licenses is reduced to four (4) with the same approved budget for the contract (ABC).
Clarification whether the following softwares are for renewal under Lot 1: Item 1: AutoCAD 3D Modeling 3DS MAX Item 3: AutoCAD including specialized toolsets Item 4: AutoCAD LT Item 5: AutoCAD Civil 3D Item 6: Sketchup Pro	Yes, the Items 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6 under Lot 1 are for renewal.
Whether the prospective bidders can be provided with the Contract Numbers or Subscription IDs for the software that are for renewal under Lot 1.	Yes, the end-users will provide the Contract Numbers or Subscription IDs for the prospective bidders for their reference upon purchase of the bidding documents.
Clarification on the timeline for the Issuance of Notice to Proceed.	Based on the posted bidding schedule, the issuance of the Notice to Proceed is scheduled on or before 27 October 2022 (<i>subject to change</i>).
Clarification on the cost of the Bidding Documents.	The bidders should pay the cost of the bidding documents in the amount of Php5,000.00.
Clarification that the 32 Licenses of Adobe Acrobat Standard DC under Lot 2 are only compatible with Microsoft Windows operating system.	The 32 Licenses of Adobe Acrobat Standard DC are for Microsoft Windows operating system.
Clarification on the submission of Product Brochures and/or other related documents containing the description and specifications	The bidders should submit product brochures and/ or equivalent document to support compliance to technical specifications requirement
In relation to the abovementioned procurement, what is the number of the Bid Bulletin to be issued?	The prospective bidders shall refer to Bid Bulletin No. BAC-G-ITS-2022-01.

Whether the Bid Securing Declaration for lot 2 in the amount of Php 22,880.00 is refundable.	Yes, the Bid Securing Declaration is refundable after the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid (LCRB)/Single Calculated Responsive Bid (SCRB) has signed the Contract.
On the description of On-Going Project(s) to be declared/submitted by the bidders. The above changes further amend the bidding documents, accordingly. The Opening of Bids will be held face-to-face at the BCDA Board Room, 2/F Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st corner 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, with video coverage.

Bidders may choose to attend the Opening of Bids in person or online via zoom.

For those who are attending in person, the following guidelines must be followed:


- A maximum of two (2) persons per participating bidder are allowed to attend the Opening of Bids and will be required to follow the BCDA Health Protocol for Visitors;
- The representative is required to present his/her vaccination card before he/she can be allowed inside the BCDA office;
- Compliance to social distancing, wearing of face masks, and body temperature screening inside BCDA office must be observed; and
- Observers/representatives who show signs of COVID-19 related symptoms such as cough, flu, fever, high body temperature, and sneezing are advised not to proceed to the BCDA Office since they will not be allowed to enter the BCDA premises.
