Is design review included in the scope of work? If not, what will the proponent do should it find design flaws?	Design review is not part of the scope of services required under the TOR. However, should the CMS find a design flaw it should be coursed through BCDA.
Can different bidders nominate one and the same professional individual for a particular key personnel position?	Yes, bidders may nominate one and the same professional for a particular key position. The written commitment to work for the project indicated in the Curriculum Vitae shall only commence once awarded the contract.
If implementation is accelerated and completed before the prescribed period of project completion, will there be a corresponding reduction to the payment of the contract?	No, there will be no deductions should the project be completed ahead of time. However, should there be time extensions on implementation, there will be no additional fee for the consultant.
Can BCDA move the deadline for the submission of Eligibility Documents?	Deadline of submission of Eligibility Documents shall be on 10 May 2018, 8:30AM.
