**REBIDDING OF THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, AND COMMISSIONING OF THE
CONCEPCION-NCC SUB-TRANSMISSION LINE FOR THE NEW CLARK CITY**

**RESOLUTION NO. 002
(Declaration of Failure of Bidding)**

The BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA), through its 2019 Corporate Budget, has put on bid the **Contract for the Rebidding of the Design, Supply, Construction, Installation, and Commissioning of the Concepcion-NCC Sub-Transmission Line**, to connect the New Clark City (NCC) to the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) Concepcion Tarlac substation, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (PhP150,000,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees.

WHEREAS, the BAC for Infrastructure, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid on 14 February 2019 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website;
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, nine (9) interested bidders bought the bid documents, namely:

1. GREENASIA CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION;
2. MN ELECTRO INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY & SERVICES, INC.;
3. JV OF RCDG CONSTRUCTION CORP AND BENDIMIL CONSTRUCTION & DEVELOPMENT CORP.;
4. GOLDENTEC CONTRACTOR CORP.;
5. PHESCO, INC.;
6. AER CONSTRUCTION DEVELOPMENT CO., INC.;
7. JC ELECTROFIELDS POWER SYSTEM, INC.;
8. WYN POWER CORPORATION; AND
9. PHILCANTECH ENTERPRISES.

WHEREAS, Out of nine (9) interested bidders who bought the bidding documents, proponent JC Electrofields submitted its bid late at 9:05AM, and six (6) submitted their proposals prior to the set deadline for submission and receipt of bids, namely:

1. Goldentec Contractor Corp.;
2. JV of RCDG Construction Corp. & Bendimil Construction;
3. AER Construction Development Co., Inc.;
4. Phesco Inc.;
5. Philcantech Enterprises; and

6. Wyn Power Corporation.

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2019, the envelopes which contained the Eligibility and Technical Requirements of the aforementioned six (6) proponents were opened and subjected to a preliminary evaluation by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using "PASS/FAIL" criterion;

WHEREAS, during the said preliminary evaluation, the BAC declared that the Omnibus Sworn Statement of Wyn Power will be verified further during the detailed bid evaluation. The BAC declared the submission of the JV of RCDG and Bendimil as INELIGIBLE due to the non-submission of the Value Engineering Analysis document. The BAC likewise declared that the Eligibility and Technical Requirements of the five (5) other bidders are complete but will still be subjected to a more detailed evaluation and verification during the detailed bid evaluation;

WHEREAS, on March 18-19, 2019, the BAC Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted a detailed bid evaluation of the submitted Eligibility and Technical Proposals of the aforementioned five (5) proponents using "PASS/FAIL" criterion. After the presence or absence of the Eligibility and Technical Requirements were ascertained, the Eligibility/Technical Bids of the said six (6) proponents were found to be non-compliant with the eligibility/technical requirements stipulated in the Bidding Documents for the project, and consequently rated "FAILED", to wit:

WHEREAS, during its meeting on March 26, 2019, the BAC for Infrastructure declared a failure of bidding for the aforementioned project, in accordance with Section 35.1 of the Revised IRR of Republic Act No. 9184, to wit:

“The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when:

*b) All prospective bidders are declared ineligible;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) for Infrastructure, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

1. To declare a **FAILURE OF BIDDING** for the Rebidding for the Contract of the Design, Supply, Construction, Installation and Commissioning of the Concepcion-NCC Sub-Transmission Line for the New Clark City;
2. For the Task Force/End-User of the Project to conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including its cost estimates, pursuant to Section 35.2 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184; and
