


Land Use Distribution



**Establish a "Meet-Me Room" or Neutral Hosting Site** through which active service providers will patch into the passive ICT network.





#### **DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE**

PSP may nominate the same entity or different entities to meet the Design Experience Req'ts and Construction Experience Req'ts

- If 1 entity is nominated to fulfill both Design and Construction Experience Requirements, the same project may be relied upon by the nominated entity.
- If 2 different entities are nominated, the PSP shall nominate only 1 entity each to meet the Design Experience Requirement and Construction Experience Requirement.
- A Contractor can be nominated by the PSP to fulfill the Design and/or Construction Experience Requirement. Different PSPs may nominate the same Contractor.

#### **Eligible Projects**

The entity nominated to fulfill the Design and Construction Experience Requirements must have <u>client-side experience</u> of satisfactorily completing the design of **ALL** of the following eligible projects, whether locally or abroad, <u>within the last five (5) years prior to the Eligibility Documents Submission Date.</u>

If the entity nominated to fulfill the Design and Construction Experience Requirements is a Telecommunications Company, it may submit its in-house experience and/or its client-side experience

#### **Design Experience Requirements – Eligible Projects**

Design of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network

More than 100 km of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network within 7 integrated passive networks, serving an identifiable, contiguous area, aggregated back to a network site with capability for interconnection to the equipment of more than 1 DTP ("Integrated Network").

Design of fiber installations to address mixed end-user base including residential and enterprise buildings, government, and other end points

More than 100,000 billable end points including mixed end-user based within 7 Integrated Networks.

Design of passive wholesale network services (e.g., end-to-end dark fiber services)

At least 1 passive fiber wholesale network delivering services to at least 2 DTPs.



#### **DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE**

#### **Construction Experience Requirements – Eligible Projects**

**Construction of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network** 

More than 100 km of underground optical fiber multi-conduit network within 7 Integrated Networks.

Construction of fiber installations to address mixed end-user base including residential and enterprise buildings, government, and other end points

More than 100,000 billable end points including mixed end-user based within 7 Integrated Networks.

Construction of passive wholesale network services (e.g., end-to-end dark fiber services)

At least 1 passive fiber wholesale network delivering services to at least 2 DTPs.



#### **DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION EXPERIENCE**

#### **PCAB License**

Any entity nominated to meet the Construction Experience Requirements must possess a Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) License Category AAA and License Classification Large B in General Engineering, General Building, Electrical Works, or Communication Facilities.

If the nominated entity is foreign, such entity must submit an equivalent license from an equivalent accreditation institution in its country of origin, provided that such foreign nominee must secure a license and accreditation from the PCAB after the PSP is awarded the Project.

#### **Shareholding Restriction**

In case the entity nominated to fulfill the Design and/or Construction Experience Requirements is a Consortium Member or the Affiliate of a Consortium Member and such entity is not also nominated to fulfill either the Maintenance Experience Requirements or the Commercialization Experience Requirements, the equity of such Consortium Member in the Consortium must not exceed thirty percent (30%).



#### **MAINTENANCE EXPERIENCE**

#### **Eligible Projects**

The PSP shall only nominate one (1) entity with either client-side or in-house experience to fulfill the Maintenance Experience Requirements and the entity nominated must have prior and current experience in maintaining the eligible projects / facilities below for a period of <u>at least five (5) consecutive years within the last seven (7) years prior to the Eligibility Documents Submission Date.</u>

#### **Maintenance Experience Requirements – Eligible Projects**

Providing connectivity and maintenance services of fiber assets to address mixed end user base including residential and enterprise buildings, government, and other end points

Service level agreements with a record showing restoration of services / repair of outages within a maximum of 8 hours for 95% of the time for the prior consecutive 5 years for (i) More than one hundred (100) kilometers of underground optical fiber multi–conduit network within seven (7) Integrated Networks AND (ii) 100,000 billable end points



#### **MAINTENANCE EXPERIENCE**

#### **Shareholding Requirement**

In case the PSP is a Consortium, the entity which fulfills the Maintenance Experience Requirements must be:

- (1) a Consortium Member, that is neither a natural person nor a sole proprietorship with at least twenty percent (20%) interest in the Consortium, or
- (2) an Affiliate of a Consortium Member with at least twenty percent (20%) interest in the Consortium.





#### **COMMERCIALIZATION EXPERIENCE**

#### **Eligible Projects**

The PSP shall only nominate one (1) entity with either client-side or in-house experience to fulfill the Commercialization Experience Requirements and the entity nominated must have prior and current experience in commercializing the eligible projects / facilities below for a period of <u>at least five (5) consecutive years within the last seven (7) years prior to the Eligibility Documents Submission Date.</u>

#### **Commercialization Experience Requirements – Eligible Projects**

Selling and leasing of wholesale passive asset services

At least 1 relevant Wholesale Services Agreement



#### **COMMERCIALIZATION EXPERIENCE**

- (1) a Consortium Member, that is neither a natural person nor a sole proprietorship with at least twenty percent (20%) interest in the Consortium, or

## (3) Financial Eligibility Requirements

## Entities to be nominated

If the PSP is a partnership or corporation:

- PSP itself
- Affiliate of the PSP that will guarantee the obligations of the PSP under the JV.

#### If the PSP is a Consortium:

 Consortium Members, by combining their respective net worth in relation to their percentage of participation in the Consortium

## Financial Capability Requirements

- Possess a net worth of at least One Billion Philippine Pesos (PhP 1,000,000,000.00) or its equivalent in foreign currency as of its latest audited financial statements for the previous three (3) financial years, the latest of which must be dated not earlier than 31 December 2022; or
- A set—aside deposit equivalent to One Billion Philippine Pesos (PhP 1,000,000,000.00) evidenced by a notarized certification from the relevant bank as proof of set—aside deposit indicating the name of the account holder and the amount of set-aside deposit.



## Lock-Up Rules

Contractors	<ul> <li>A Contractor solely proposed to meet a particular Technical Capability Requirement cannot Withdraw except in a Substitution with another qualified substitute.</li> <li>If a Contractor is not the sole nominated entity proposed to meet a particular Technical Capability Requirement, the remaining Contractors shall confirm in writing their continued participation.</li> </ul>


