**WHEREAS**, on 23 March 2024, BAC-G, through its Secretariat, advertised/posted the Invitation to Bid, including the bidding documents, on the following platforms:

- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

**WHEREAS**, BAC-G conducted a Pre-bid Conference on 01 April 2024 at 10:00 AM, which was attended by the following prospective bidders:

- c. Toyota Manila Bay
- d. Toyota Quezon Avenue, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, the prospective bidders have the option to submit a bid offer on any or all lots and evaluation and contract award will be undertaken on a per-lot basis;

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**WHEREAS**, in response to said advertisements, three (3) bidders submitted their bids before the deadline of submission of bids at 09:00 AM on 19 April 2024 (Wednesday) at the BCDA Corporate Center, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, viz:

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing and consistent with Section 34 of Rule X (Post-Qualification) of the 2016 RIRR of RA 9184, the BAC-G-Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted a Post-Qualification Evaluation on **Toyota Fairview, Inc.** on 29 April - 10 May 2024 to determine if **Toyota Fairview, Inc.** is legally, technically, and financially capable to undertake the project and responsive to all the bidding requirements, including the specifications/terms of reference as stated in the bidding documents;

**WHEREAS**, in the 14 May 2024 (Tuesday) meeting of the BAC-G, its members concurred with the TWG's recommendation, declaring the **Toyota Fairview, Inc.** as post-disqualified due to its non-compliance with the submission of all its ongoing Government and Private Contracts;

**WHEREAS**, BAC-TWG proceeded with the conduct of the Post-Qualification Evaluation with the Second Lowest Calculated Bid, **Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.** , on 15 May - 24 May 2024 to determine if **Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.** is legally, technically, and financially capable to undertake the project and responsive to all the bidding requirements, including the specifications/terms of reference as stated in the bidding documents;

**WHEREAS**, in the 28 May 2024 (Tuesday) meeting of the BAC-G, its members concurred with the TWG's recommendation, declaring **Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.** as both eligible, technically, and financially capable to undertake the project.

**ACCORDINGLY**, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

1. To declare **TOYOTA PASONG TAMO INC.** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) for the **Procurement of Supply and Delivery of Twenty-One (21) Units Motor Vehicles**; and,
2. To award the contract to **TOYOTA PASONG TAMO INC.**, being the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) for this Project, in the amount of **Thirty Four Million Nine Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Five Pesos (Php34,914,775.00)**, inclusive of VAT and all other applicable taxes and fees, as follows:
