CANCELLATION OF PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF A HEALTH CARE SERVICE PROVIDER FOR CY 2022-2023

RESOLUTION NO. BG-HMO-2022-01

WHEREAS, the Health Care Services of BCDA for CY 2022-2023 has an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Eight Million Seven Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand Pesos (PhP8,738,000.00), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (**BAC-G**), has started the procurement activities for this project such as the advertisement/posting of the Invitation to Bid including the bidding document on 03 May 2022 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. In a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA.

WHEREAS, a Pre-bid Conference on 11 May 2022 has been conducted which was attended by the following prospective bidders:

- a. Cocolife Health Care; and
- b. Philippine British Assurance Company Inc.

WHEREAS, Cocolife Health Care bought the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (BAC-G) received the request of end-user as contained in its 17 May 2022 memo to the BAC-G postponing the submission of bids for this project in view of the receipt by BCDA of Executive Order 150 (series of 2021);

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods (BAC-G) issued Bid Bulletin No. BAC-G-HMO-2022-01 dated 18 May 2022 postponing the submission of bids for this project pending the evaluation by the BAC-G of the propriety of the procurement considering the effectivity of Executive Order 150 (series of 2021);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 41 (c) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) reserves the right to declare a failure of bidding or not award the contract in the following situations:

XXX

"(c) For any justifiable and reasonable ground where the award of the contract will not redound to the benefit of the GoP, as follows: (i) if the physical and







economic conditions have significantly changed so as to render the project no longer economically, financially, or technically feasible, as determined by the HoPE; (ii) if the project is no longer necessary as determined by the HoPE; or (iii) if the source of funds for the project has been withheld or reduced through no fault of the Procuring Entity."

WHEREAS, in the 23 May 2022 Memo to BAC-G, the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) approved the request of the end-user to cancel the procurement for this project after BCDA received the Executive Order No. 150 (series of 2021) mandating the discontinuation of health care benefits of the Government Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), such as BCDA, as stated in Section IX of Compensation and Position Classification System (CPCS) covered by RA No.10149, to wit:

"XXX they must not procure another health insurance in addition to the health program already provided by the government through PhilHealth."

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

- To declare a cancellation of bidding and termination of the conduct of procurement activities for the PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF A HEALTH CARE SERVICE PROVIDER FOR CY 2022-2023; and
- 2. To refund payments to the agencies who bought the bid documents.
