**CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF
THE LONG-TERM PERMANENT WORKS AT PASIG-POTRERO BRIDGE OF
THE SUBIC-CLARK-TARLAC EXPRESSWAY**

THE PUBLIC IS INFORMED:

This Contract made and executed by and between:

BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, a government instrumentality vested with corporate powers created and existing under Republic Act No. 7227, as amended, with principal office and place of business at BCDA Corporate Center, 2/F Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st Street, corner 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, Metro Manila, represented herein by its President and Chief Executive Officer, **ARNEL PACIANO D. CASANOVA, Esq.**, who is duly authorized for the purpose, under Section VIII, Subject No. 8.02 Item 2.b, a certified true copy of which is hereto attached as **Annex "A"** and made as an integral part hereof, hereinafter referred to as "BCDA";

- and -

PHILIPP'S TECHNICAL CONSULTANTS CORPORATION, a private corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at 8F España Tower, 2203 España Boulevard corner Josefina St., Sampaloc, Manila represented herein by its General Manager, **GREGORIO B. CARONAN**, who is duly authorized for this purpose, as evidenced by a Secretary's Certificate dated JULY 04, 2014, a certified true copy of which is hereto attached as **Annex "B"** and made integral part hereof, referred to as the "CONSTRUCTION MANAGER".

ANTECEDENTS

On 20 August 2013, as a result of torrential rains triggered by Typhoon "Maring" and southwest monsoon or "Habagat", the strong lahar currents along the Pasig-Potrero River eroded the embankment on the approach of the Pasig-Potrero Bridge of the Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway (SCTEX). The incident caused the closure of the segment of the SCTEX from Clark South to Porac to ensure the safety of motorists.

BCDA will undertake the Long-Term Permanent Works at Pasig-Potrero Bridge of SCTEX, hereinafter referred to as the "Project";

BCDA needs the services of a Construction Management and Supervision (CMS) firm to oversee, supervise, monitor and control the day-to-day operations of the Project and to see to it that the Project is completed on schedule, in accordance with plans and specifications and within the approved budget;

On 13 May 2014, the BCDA received and opened the bids of participating consulting firms for the Project. After careful evaluation and review of the technical and financial proposals, the BCDA - Bids and Award Committee-for SCTEP and Infrastructure (BAC-SI) found the proposal of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER to be the Highest Rated and Responsive Bid (HRRB);

WHEREAS, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER represents that it has the necessary training, experience, capability, technology, manpower, equipment and financial resources required to

provide construction management services strictly in accordance with the requirements of BCDA;

WHEREAS, consistent with the recommendation of the BAC-SI, Resolution No. BIP-2014-025, declaring the Highest Rated and Responsive Bid, the BCDA Management approved the award of the Contract to the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER for the Construction Management and Supervision of the Long-Term Permanent Works at Pasig-Potrero Bridge of SCTEX in the amount of PESOS: Seven Million One Hundred Twenty Three Thousand Six Hundred Eighty and 00/100 (P7,123,680.00), inclusive of VAT and all taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual covenants and stipulations herein contained, the Parties hereby agree and bind themselves to the following:

ARTICLE I DEFINITION OF TERMS

Unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms shall have the meanings provided in this Article:

- 1.1 **BCDA** refers to Bases Conversion and Development Authority.
- 1.2 **CONSTRUCTION MANAGER** refers to Philipp's Technical Consultants Corporation, which has been contracted by BCDA to undertake the Construction Management and Supervision (CMS) of the Project.
- 1.3 **CONTRACT** means this contract including the Annexes pertinent to the Construction Management and Supervision of the Long-Term Permanent Works at Pasig-Potrero Bridge of SCTEX.
- 1.4 **CONSTRUCTOR** is the duly licensed general engineering and building Contractor contracted by BCDA to undertake the works of the Project.
- 1.5 **GOVERNMENT** refers to the Government of the Republic of the Philippines.
- 1.6 **PARTIES** refer to BCDA and the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER.
- 1.7 **PROJECT** refers to the Long-Term Permanent Works at Pasig-Potrero Bridge of SCTEX.

ARTICLE II THE SERVICES

- 2.1 **Scope of Work.** The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall perform the services described in the Terms of Reference (TOR) for Construction Management and Supervision (CMS) for the Project, hereto attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof.
- 2.2 The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall be responsible for the preparation and submission of all forms and supporting documents required by the Commission on Audit (COA) and other government agencies.
- 2.3 **Commencement of the Services.** The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall commence the Services as stated in the Notice to Proceed. It shall give written notice

give BCDA all data compiled, drawings and preliminary conclusions made up to the date of the termination.

**ARTICLE XI
LIABILITY OF THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER**

- 11.1 **Professional Quality and Technical Accuracy.** The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall be responsible for the professional quality, technical accuracy, and coordination of all Services performed under this Contract. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall, without additional compensation, correct or revise any defect, error or deficiency in its Services.
- 11.2 **Rights and Remedies.** The rights and remedies of BCDA provided for under this Contract are in addition to any other right and remedy provided by pertinent laws and other issuances.

**ARTICLE XII
NO EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE RELATIONSHIP**

- 12.1 There is no employer-employee relationship between BCDA and the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, its employees, agents, suppliers, and consultants. Consequently, BCDA shall not in any way be liable and/or responsible for any personal injury including death or damage to property sustained or caused by or attributed to any of the employees of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER whether or not occurring during the performance of their duties. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees and binds itself to indemnify BCDA for whatever injuries or damages directly or indirectly caused or occasioned or attributed to the fault, negligence or conduct of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER and/or its employees, agents, suppliers or consultants arising out of, or in connection with, or on the occasion of the performance of their duties and to be liable and/or responsible for the enforcement of, and compliance with all existing laws, including the Labor Code of the Philippines, executive or administrative orders, rules and regulations, and binds itself to save and hold BCDA free and harmless from any and all liabilities in respect thereof and/or arising therefrom and/or by reason of this Contract and its implementation.

**ARTICLE XIII
MISCELLANEOUS**

- 13.1 **Effectivity.** The Contract shall remain in force until the completion of all the necessary documents required for payments and turnover of the completed Project in accordance with government accounting and auditing rules and regulations from the date reflected in the Notice to Proceed.
- 13.2 **Notices and Addresses.** All notices called for by the terms of this Contract shall be effective only at the time of receipt thereof and only when received by the Parties to whom they are addressed at the following addresses:





Greetings!

This refers to a failure in posting we have encountered during an attempt to post a Notice of Award relative to the bidding for the Construction Management and Supervision of the Long-Term Permanent Works at Pasig-Potrero Bridge of the Subic-Clark-Tarlac Expressway (SCTEX).

BCDA posted in the PhilGEPS last 28 March 2014 a Request for Expression of Interest relative to the bidding (Reference number 2599211). BCDA's Bids and Awards Committee issued a Resolution shortlisting the interested consultants, and Mr. Randolph Austria, the authorized personnel to post in the PhilGEPS for the BAC, also shortlisted the suppliers in the system. The status of the notice is now "shortlisted". Later, Mr. Austria, after obtaining the required supporting documents (i.e. Notice of Award, Contract Agreement and Notice to Proceed), tried to post/upload said documents in the system. However, the necessary commands to post the award notice and upload the documents as shown in the PhilGEPS Manual on Postings were not available in the bidding abstract; hence, the award was not posted. We also note that the abstract and/or commands were different from the one shown in the Manual available in our office.

Mr. Austria reported this matter to your office thru phone call and later thru email on 16 September 2014. We received a response through email explaining that the current system now requires the posting of a 2nd notice and that the posting of the award notice can only be created when the status of the 2nd notice changes to "closed". In the same email, it was concluded that since the 2nd bid notice was not created, the award cannot be posted.

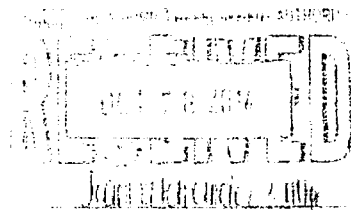
